The University of Waikato College offers a range of programmes suitable for students at different stages of their academic journey. Whether you're looking to undertake an undergraduate degree, postgraduate degree, or simply improve your English fluency, the University of Waikato College is here to support you in achieving your academic goals. Now it's time to find the right programme for you.

FOUNDATION STUDIES

The Certificate of Attainment in Foundation Studies is a pathway programme that prepares you for university studies. Students who pass all their papers and achieve a B- in their English language papers will gain entry to a range of degrees at the University. Please seek advice from the College on entry requirements specific to your chosen progression degree.

The duration of the programme is five months (one trimester) or eight to nine months (two trimesters), depending on a student's academic background and English language proficiency.

Programme length: 8-9 months (2 trimesters)

English entry requirements: IELTS score of 5.5 (no band less than 5.0)

Award: Level 4 Certificate (NZQCF)

Foundation Studies programme – accelerated

Programme length: 5 months (1 trimester)
English entry requirements: IELTS score of
5.5 (with at least 5.5 in the Writing and one other band, and no band less than 5.0)

Award: Level 4 Certificate (NZQCF)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES

Our English language programmes enhance the language skills of our international students while providing essential academic support. Our courses encompass English for academic writing, research, and critical analysis, creating a comprehensive approach that nurtures not only effective communication but also academic excellence. Guided by experienced and supportive teachers, students thrive both in their communication abilities and their academic studies.

ACADEMIC ENGLISH

Our academic English programmes (Certificate of Attainment in English Language and Certificate of Attainment in Academic English) are designed for students who need to improve their English language skills in order to study an academic course. Passing Level 7 or 8 of the Academic English language programme with a B grade or better provides direct entry to degree study without the need for further IELTS testing. Please note that some quals (e.g. BTchg, MTchgLn) will still require students to meet English language requirements as they have an entry point of IELTS 7.0. The programme offers intakes in February, May, August, and October.

ACCELERATE YOUR ACADEMIC JOURNEY

Undertaking an International Diploma or Pre-Masters Diploma will prepare you to start your chosen degree, whilst giving you extra support with academic English.

INTERNATIONAL DIPLOMA (BUSINESS)

Kickstart your career in the business field with the International Diploma (Business). This programme incorporates the first-year papers of the Bachelor of Business with English language development, a complete programme of academic support, and other development activities to ensure you are well equipped to undertake higher education studies in New Zealand.

Once you have completed the International Diploma (Business), you will be eligible for direct entry into year two of the Bachelor of Business (BBus) at the Waikato Management School, a Triple Crown accredited business school.

INTERNATIONAL DIPLOMA (COMPUTER SCIENCE)

Computer Science is rapidly changing the world we live in and there will be an increasingly high demand for qualified computer professionals in an ever-changing climate.

Once you have completed the International Diploma (Computer Science), you will be eligible to enrol into year two of the Bachelor of Science (BSc), majoring in Computer Science or Data Analytics, or the Bachelor of Computer Science (BCompSc) at the University of Waikato.

An overall IELTS score of 6.0 (with no band less than 5.5), or equivalent.

Academic entry requirements: At least 2 years' full time successful tertiary study and a qualification equivalent to NZQCF Level 6.

Duration: 8 - 9 months (two trimesters)

Intakes: July, November

Points: 120

Award: Level 7 Diploma (NZQCF)

Location: Hamilton

PROGRESSION DEGREES

Successfully completing the Pre-Masters (DipPP)† means that you will be eligible to progress to a wide range of Masters programmes to enhance your academic knowledge, upskill and provide new career opportunities:

- Master of Applied Finance
- · Master of Business and Management
- Master of Digital Business
- Master of Information Technology*
- Master of Legal Studies*
- Master of Management in Supply Chain Management
- Master of Nursing Practice*
- Master of Professional Accounting

To gain admission to one of the five progression degrees in Business students need to complete the DipPP, which requires a pass in each of the six papers (a result of 50%/C-or more is required to pass a paper).

*Progression to the 240-point Master of Information Technology requires a minimum GPA of 4.5. Progression to the Master of Legal Studies requires a B grade average. Progression to the Master of Nursing Practice requires a B grade average – Limited spaces available. Additional prerequisites for admission apply.




TRIPLE CROWN ACCREDITATION
